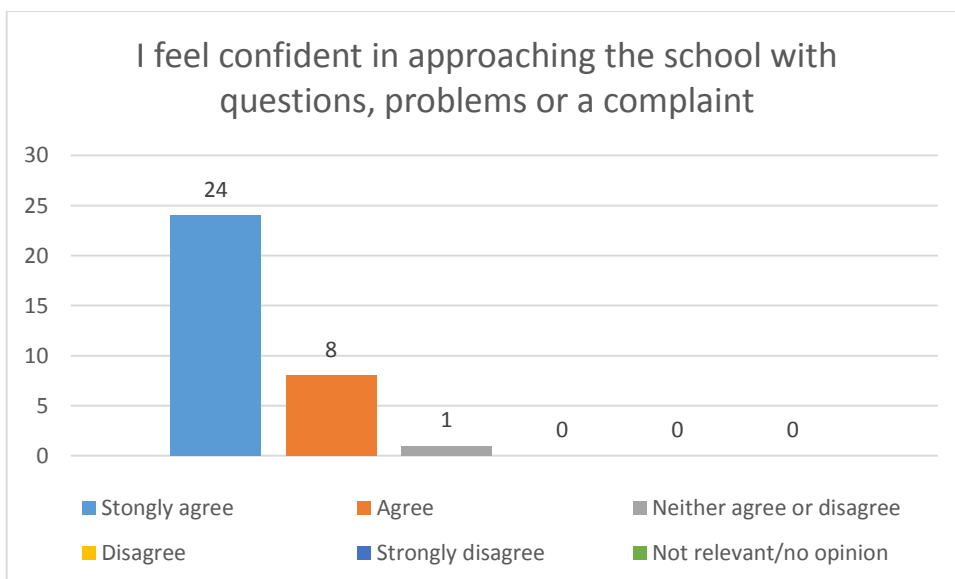
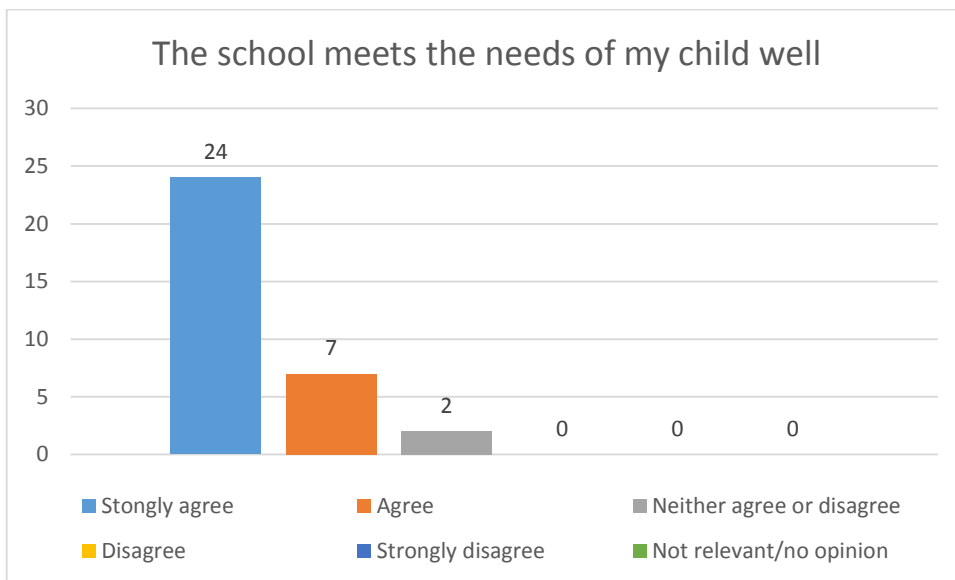
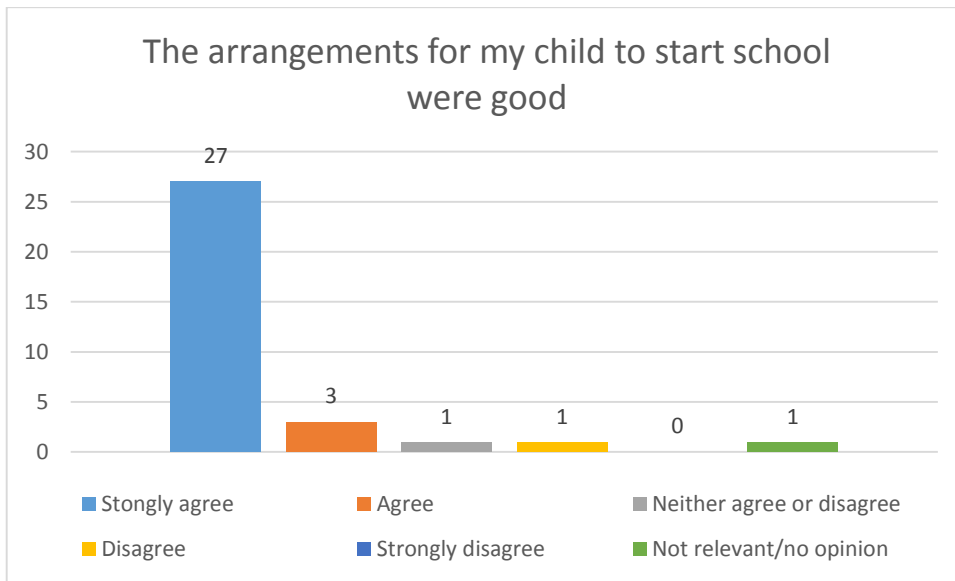
General Comments

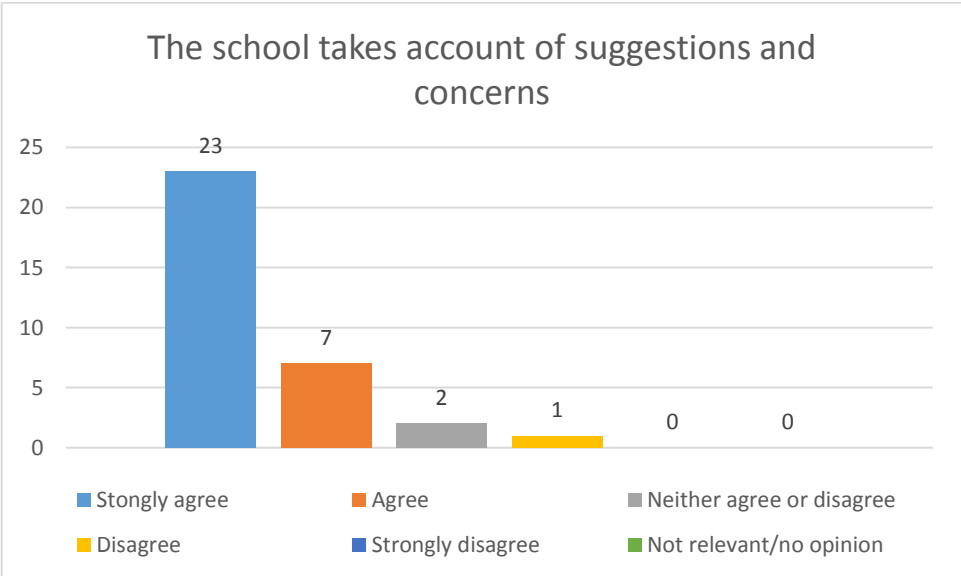
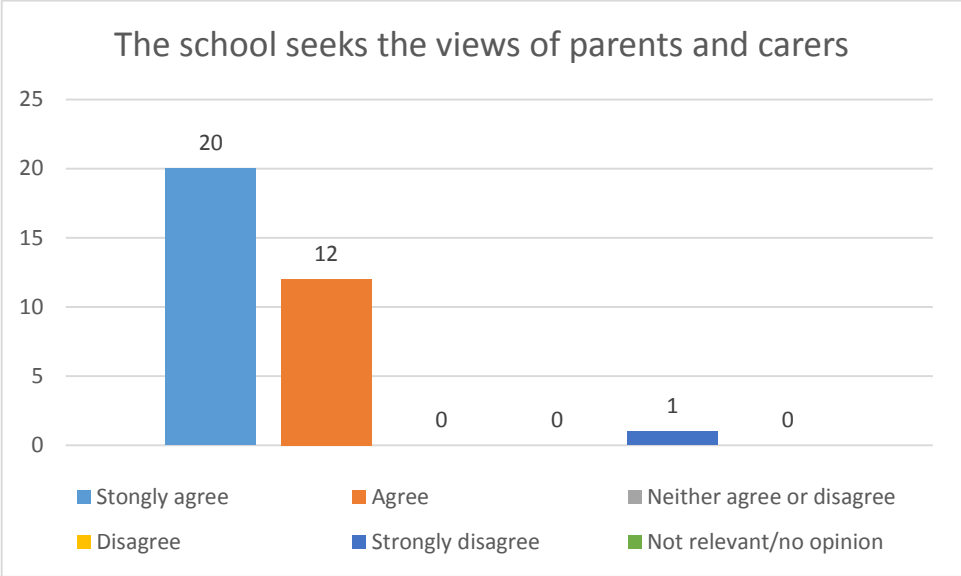
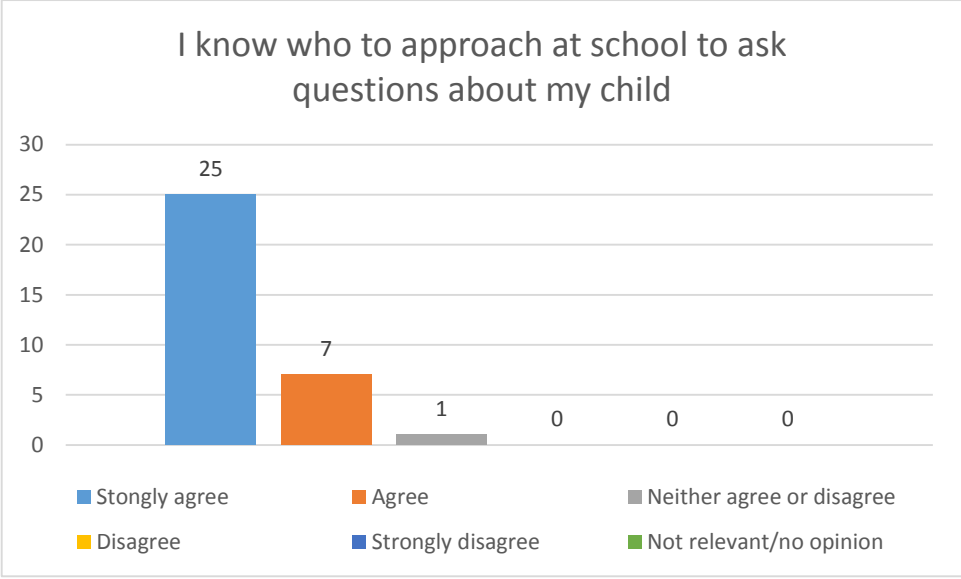
- I love the parent interaction, this is why we chose you over the Brier. I hope it continues through all of school and not just reception.
