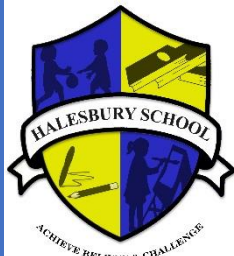

IMPORTANT EVENTS:

Halesbury Family Outreach Team organise family events throughout the year for families to come together in a safe and supportive space. We hold a parent/carer pamper evening in May, Summer Fayre / Halesbury Festival in July and a Christmas Fayre in December. PARENTS EVENINGS:

Halesbury holds three Parents Evenings a year:

Autumn Term – (Sept-Dec time) - Meet & Greet

Spring Term – (Jan-March time) – Curriculum

Summer Term – (April-July time) - End of year reports/discussions

EHCP

Your child will have a yearly review of their statement/Education, Health, Care Plan, (EHCP). This is called an Annual Review, these will take place: Whole School – May & Year 11 – December.

IIP'S

Each child in school will have an IIP, (Individual Intervention Plan) which looks at children's individual needs and the support they will need. These will be produced every term and are reviewed three times a year.

YEAR 9 & 10 OPTIONS MEETING:

These meetings are to look at what subjects children will choose for their end of school qualifications. These meetings will take place in the Summer Term.
